



## Quick Guide to download eBooks

### What are eBooks?

- eBooks are just like physical books that you read with your eyes.
- eBooks are borrowed from Live-brary.com and downloaded onto a computer. eBooks can be read on a computer or transferred to a portable reading device.
- eBooks do not have to be returned. eBooks downloaded from Live-brary.com are DRM (Digital Rights Management) compliant. This means they can be read only during the lending period; after that period they can no longer be read by the computer or the portable device.
